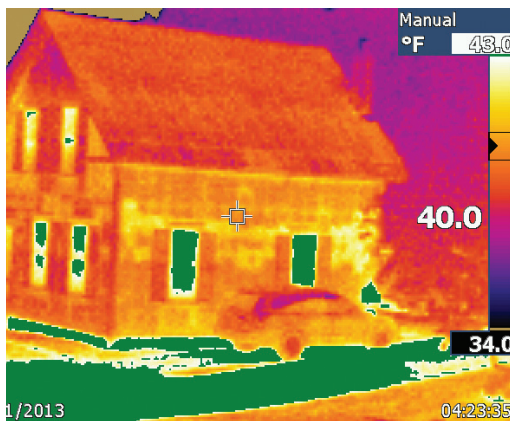
Thermal (IR) Camera Workshop
